Courses Offered

B.PHARM

Course Duration: 4 years | Intake: 60

General Criteria for admission to Pharmacy courses:

- Candidate must have passed '10+2' examination with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics / Biology as compulsory subjects with individual pass marks (in both theory and practical wherever applicable) in all the three subjects as stated above in regular class mode.
- Must have obtained at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category e.g. SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B, PWD) in the above three subjects taken together.
- Must have passed English in the '10+2' examination with at least 30% marks.
- The Board of the said Qualifying Examination must be recognized by the Central Government or State Government concerned. However, as per the rules of the concerned Regulatory Body, the students possessing 10+2 qualification from non-formal and non-classrooms-based schooling such as National Institute of Open Schooling, open school systems of States etc. shall not be eligible for admission to B.Pharm course.







D.PHARM

Course Duration: 2 years | Intake: 60

Eligibility Criteria:

- Candidates must be Indian Citizen.
- Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent examination in General Stream Course with Physics, Chemistry & Biology or Mathematics.
- Candidates passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examination or equivalent examination in Vocational Stream Courses are not eligible for admission, as per prescribed admission eligibility of Pharmacy Council of India
- Candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 1st January of the year for admission to the Pharmacy Course.


